Sea Scotland 2018 will be held **at the Bay Hotel and Conference centre in the Kingdom of Fife**. The following practical information is designed to help you organise your stay.

Finding the conference centre

The Bay Hotel is easily accessible by rail, bus and car and on foot.

By Rail

The nearest rail station is in Kinghorn. Direct services run from Dundee, Perth, Aberdeen and Edinburgh, and connecting services from Oban, Inverness and Glasgow. Once in Kinghorn, the Bay Hotel is a short walk, bus or taxi ride away.

By Bus

You can take the No. 7 bus from Burntisland, Kinghorn (10 minutes) or Kirkcaldy.

On foot

The conference centre is approximately 20 minutes walking from Kinghorn, 40 minutes from Burntisland along the Fife coastal path.

By Car

Onsite parking is available to delegates. Please contact the Bay Hotel for further information.
